The Niles Park District again is offering installments with the “Hat Trick Payment Plan.” Only \$300 is required at the time of registration. The remaining balance is divided into two installments. The first installment will be processed on October 15<sup>th</sup> and the final installment will be processed on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Post dated checks, or authorized credit card number, for each installment are required at time of registration.

Pre-requisite: All Mites must have completed one year of Rookie Ranger classes or be evaluated by the hockey director. Squirts, Pee Wees, Bantams, and Midgets must have prior team experience or be evaluated by the hockey director. Pee Wees, Bantams and Midgets must have attended a 2 hour checking clinic before evaluations. ALL Players must register on line with USA HOCKEY, and present a copy of their confirmation number when registering.

Requirements: Complete equipment is required including neck guards. Mouth guards are recommended for Mites and Squirts, and are mandatory for Pee Wees and above. A copy of the player’s birth certificate must be on file. New players in the Rangers organization must provide a copy of their birth certificate at time of registration.

Description: **Silver Mites** will play an in-house developmental program with weekly group practices or cross ice games. There may be travel to other rinks for cross ice week-end jamborees. Silver Mites will start practices in October and will not participate in evaluations or play in the NWHL. Silver Mites will participate in the Ice Company Skill Development Clinics for 20 weeks on Tuesdays at 5:40 pm starting in October.

**Gold Mite thru Midget** Ranger teams will participate in the Northwest Hockey League. Some travel to other rinks is required. Teams play 18 games, 9 home and 9 away, October thru February, and a playoff tournament in March. The tournament fee is included. All teams will have weekly split ice practices. Players will also receive skills clinics, power skates and extra practices determined by amount of teams and ice availability. Evaluations will begin September 4th. Additional dates and times will be made available at time of registration.

**Mite** players will participate in Ice Company Skill Development Clinics on Tuesdays starting at 5:40 pm, beginning in October. Enrollment numbers permitting; Mites will attend 20 weeks of clinics. Otherwise, Mites will be divided into two groups and will attend two, five week sessions throughout the season. The Niles Park District is defraying a portion of the cost, and the program is included in the registration fees.

**New this year: Girls U12** will play in an all girls recreational league. The season will include 10-12 games and weekly practices. The team will play other girls teams from the north and west suburbs. This is a great opportunity for girls wanting to play hockey. Call IceLand's Hockey Director for more information, 847-297-8031.

Jerseys and socks are not included in the registration fees. Returning players may use jerseys from a prior season or purchase new. All players are required to have home and away jerseys and socks. Jersey numbers will be issued at time of registration. Players with even year of birth will get even numbers and players with odd year of birth will get odd numbers. Jerseys and socks may be purchased from inventory in stock or from the concession operators at IceLand. You will keep your jersey number every year you play with the Rangers.
